

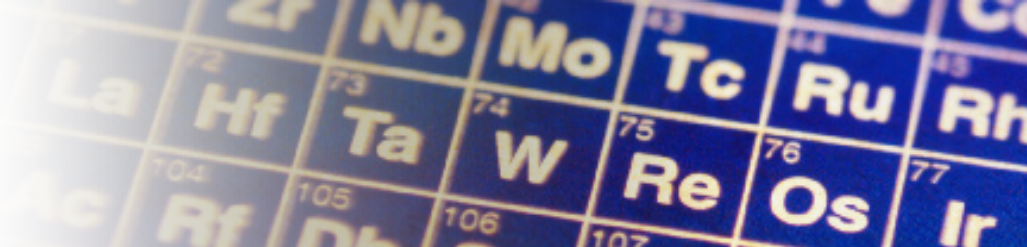
CSA Trust Mike Lynch Award

1. The Mike Lynch Award is presented by the Chemical Structure Association Trust (CSA trust) in recognition of the lifetime work of scientists with extraordinary achievements in chemistry education, chemical research and chemical development. In particular, achievements in the fields of computer-based chemistry and chemical structure clarification are honoured. Systems and methods used in the teaching and research of the prize winners must relate to the storage, processing, retrieval and further processing of technical chemical information on structures, reactions and properties.
2. The Mike Lynch Award is endowed with \$ 5,000. It is awarded every three years. The prize-winners are chosen by a five-member commission consisting of members of the CSA board of trustees.
3. The awards ceremony is held at a scientific conference important to the particular field. The winner is invited as a guest lecturer. The awards were presented at the International Conference on Chemical Structures in Noordwijkerhout, The Netherlands.
4. Scientists who are eligible for the award based on their life's work can be proposed to the CSA Trust by anyone. Members of the CSA selection commission are not permitted to make nominations. If no suitable nominations are received by the CSA Trust, the prize will not be awarded.

The proposal must be accompanied by the following documents stating reasons and providing evidence for the nomination:

- a letter stating the reasons for the nomination and providing an evaluation of the work.
- a short biography of the nominated person with their scientific qualifications and contact data.
- at least two letters of reference in which support for the nomination is confirmed and a factual statement of the reasons for the support is provided.

A list of publications may accompany the nomination.
